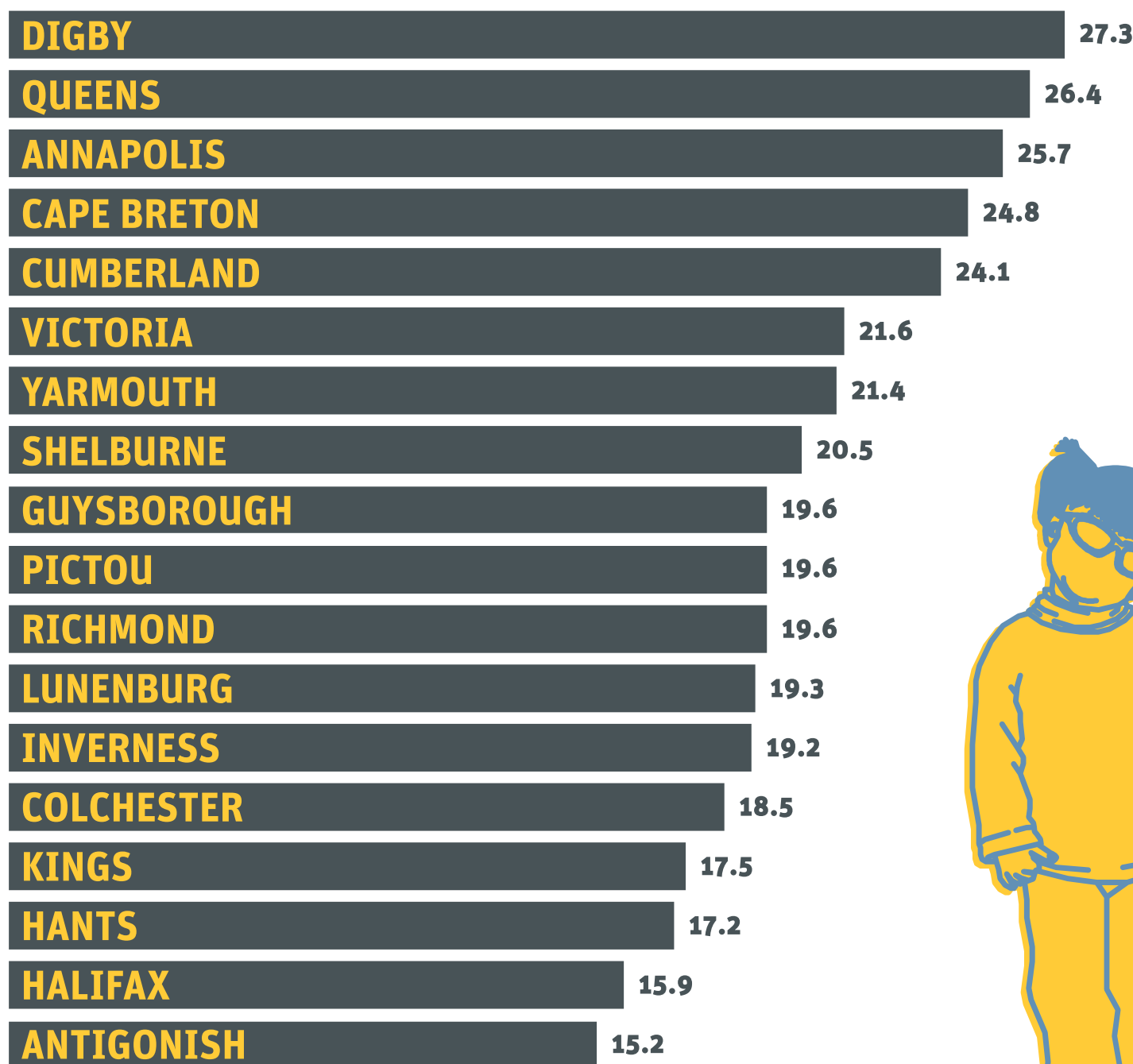


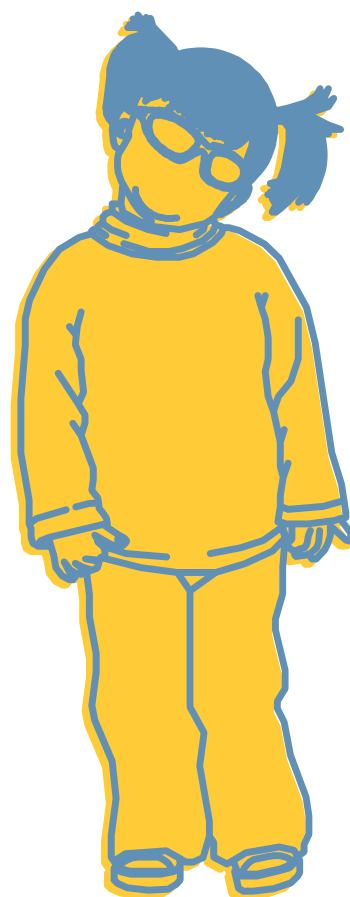

Government transfers work: without temporary pandemic benefits, **14,500** additional children would have fallen into poverty.

99% of temporary COVID-19 benefits were from the federal government. **Only 0.3%** came from the Nova Scotia government.
